School Tour Information

Shark Reef Aquarium is a proud supporter of the Clark County School District and offers weekday educational tours free of charge to all Clark County public schools. Listed below are details of Shark Reef Aquarium's offerings for Clark County school teachers.

1. Shark Reef Aquarium offers two educational tours per day, Monday through Friday.
2. All educational tours will start at 9:45 a.m. and will last approximately 2 hours. Tours consist of a guided tour of Shark Reef Aquarium, and learning activities in Shark Reef Aquarium's classroom.
3. Reservations are required for all educational tours, and are set for two times per year. Please visit www.sharkreef.com for upcoming reservation dates, or call (702) 632-4555, option 2.
4. Shark Reef Aquarium can accommodate 2 groups of 30 children and 5 chaperones (teachers are considered chaperones) each morning, for a total program size of 60 children and 10 chaperones. One group of 30 students will start on tour, and one group of 30 students will start in the classroom. Extra chaperones will be required to pay the full Shark Reef Aquarium admission price of \$13.95. No exceptions.
5. Please be aware that dates fill up quickly and bus availability is extremely limited. You are responsible for making transportation arrangements. Please reserve your bus as soon as you make your reservation.
