
14 Flashback!

Local 14 Teamster Leader Fined and Suspended

For "entering into sham contracts" and "failing to enforce contracts"

Following years of an infamous history and federal government intervention, a court appointed board was formed just to monitor Teamster activities. The Independent Review Board (IRB) investigates charges against Teamster officials and levies appropriate fines and suspensions.



The cases listed by the IRB in its June/July (2007) report include:

Hoffa supporter Gary Mauger, principal officer of Las Vegas Local 14, was charged by the IRB with entering into sham contracts, and failing to enforce contracts. Joint Council 42, run by Hoffa vice presidents James Santangelo and Randy Cammack, dealt with these serious offenses by telling Mauger not to do it anymore!
