## A Tradition of Investigations


### Long History of Suspensions and Corruption Revealed

57 years ago the cover of The Milwaukee Journal featured a story that's become all too familiar when talking about the Teamsters—turmoil and trouble. The article focuses on asking members to dig deep into their pockets to pay for a defense fund. Officers and business agents from all 800 Teamster locals were asked to fork over \$1,000—a lot of money now and especially in 1957—“in anticipation of a wave of litigation” if the union was booted out by the AFL-CIO. What was the AFL-CIO so hot about?

*“The giant truck union is the AFL-CIO’s largest affiliate. It already has been suspended from the federation by the AFL-CIO executive council on charges of failing to clean out corrupt influences. It is slated for ouster at the federation’s biennial convention which starts Dec. 5 at Atlantic City, NJ.”*

That was then, but fast forward to 2007, 50-years later and you can still find headlines about Teamster leaders fined and suspended for “entering into sham contracts” and “failing to enforce contracts” (See Weekly Report Vol. 2, Issue 1 at [www.esea-nv.org](http://www.esea-nv.org)).
